What is a potential drawback of an inhaler?

Portable, light compact

No preparation of medicines is needed

Some devices may not work well for people with limited strength of breathing in during or after an exacerbation or as disease becomes more severe-this is called peak inspiratory flow and can be measured by a simple device called in-check
